

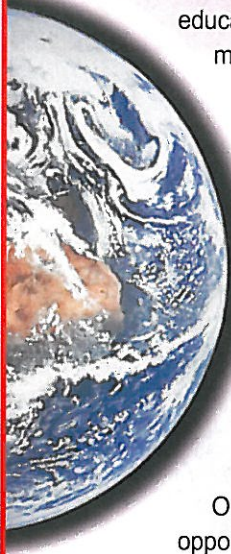
Let your classroom take flight . . .

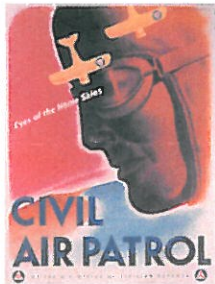
